### Key Responsibilities:

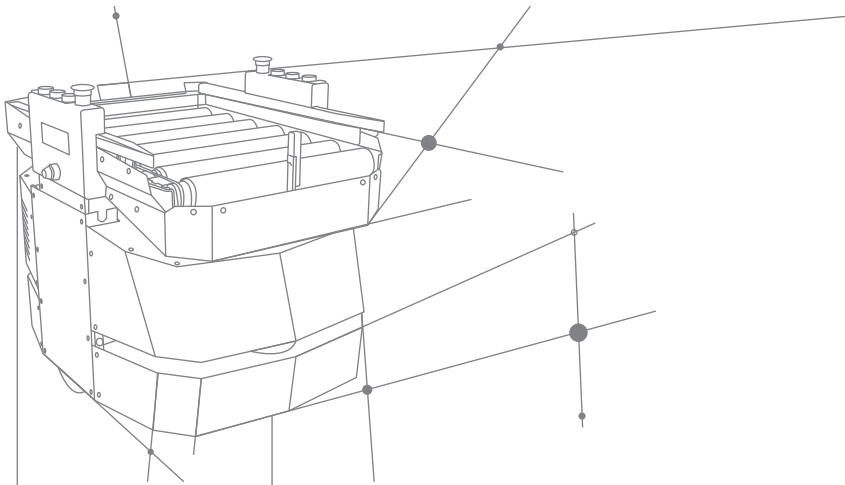
- Carry out the duties of the Principal Designer in line with the requirements of the CDM Regulations 2015
